This is where the iconic Oulu dialect mugs come to life!

During your visit, you'll get an inside look at the studio's operations and learn about the journey of clay as it transforms into ceramics. You'll also experience the magic of shaping clay with your own hands in a mini workshop, where you'll create a lovely decorative bird. As a memento of your visit, you will also receive a beautifully glazed bird, crafted for you by participants of previous courses.
